

The reply from the WFC Secretary-General by email on December 16, 2010

Dear Miyako Sakurai:

Thank you for your attached recent letter received September 16, 2010.

The WFC understands that there is no legal regulation of chiropractic in Japan, that the situation in your country is very confused, and that the WFC's policies only have persuasive force.

You ask the WFC not to become involved. What the WFC does is dictated by its members worldwide, including the Japanese Association of Chiropractors (JAC) in Japan. The position of the WFC's membership is quite clear - that chiropractors should not be teaching adjustment to non-chiropractors and that the WFC should seek to enforce such policy when it receives complaints.
